February 24, 2025- Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative (WREC) is excited to announce our \$12,000 scholarships available to high school seniors. The application deadline is **March 31, 2025**. This is an incredible opportunity for students to receive financial support for their higher education.

Since 1997, the WREC Educational Foundation has awarded 2,524 scholarships, totaling over \$19.8 million to high school seniors. This year, we are offering 110 scholarships, each valued at \$12,000. This initiative represents a significant investment in the future of our youth, helping to alleviate the financial pressures of pursuing higher education and empowering students to reach their fullest potential.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school senior with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- Be a bona fide resident within the WREC service area for at least one year prior to December 31.
- Be a dependent of a WREC Member.
- Plan to attend an in-state college, university, or technical school full-time (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester). Schools must be accredited by one of the six regional accrediting institutions recognized by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation. Technical schools should be accredited by the Council on Occupational Education or its equivalent.
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA each semester (or higher if mandated by the institution) to retain eligibility.

"We are committed to supporting the educational aspirations of our youth," said David Lambert, WREC's General Manager. "These scholarships are a testament to our dedication to empowering the next generation and helping them achieve their dreams."
